

# M.E.S.A. – Post Evacuation, Returning People with Medical Dependencies Home

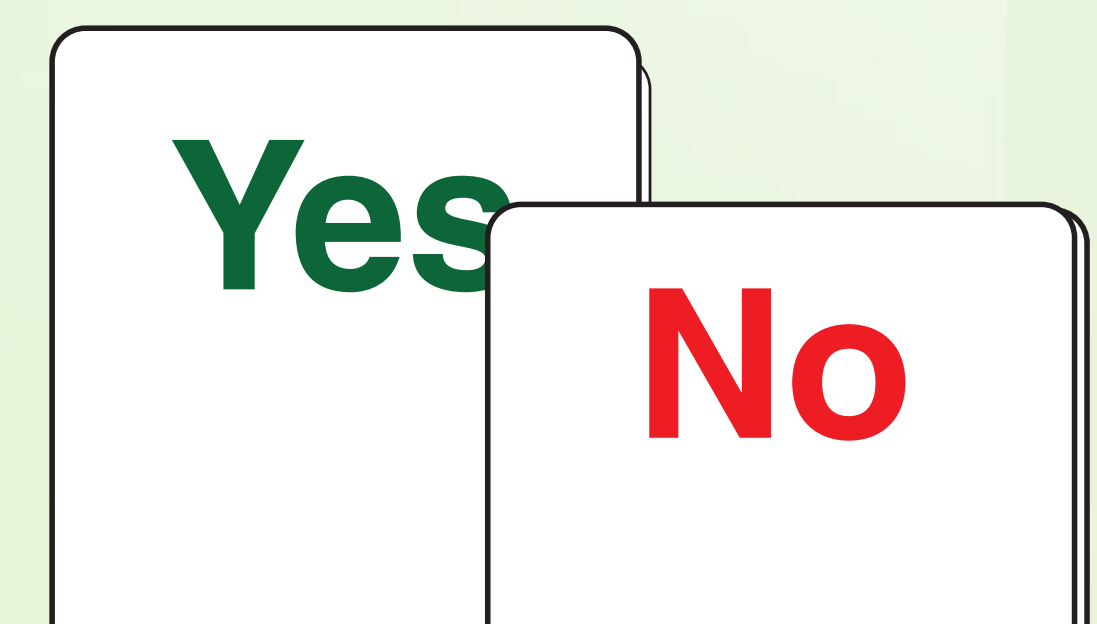

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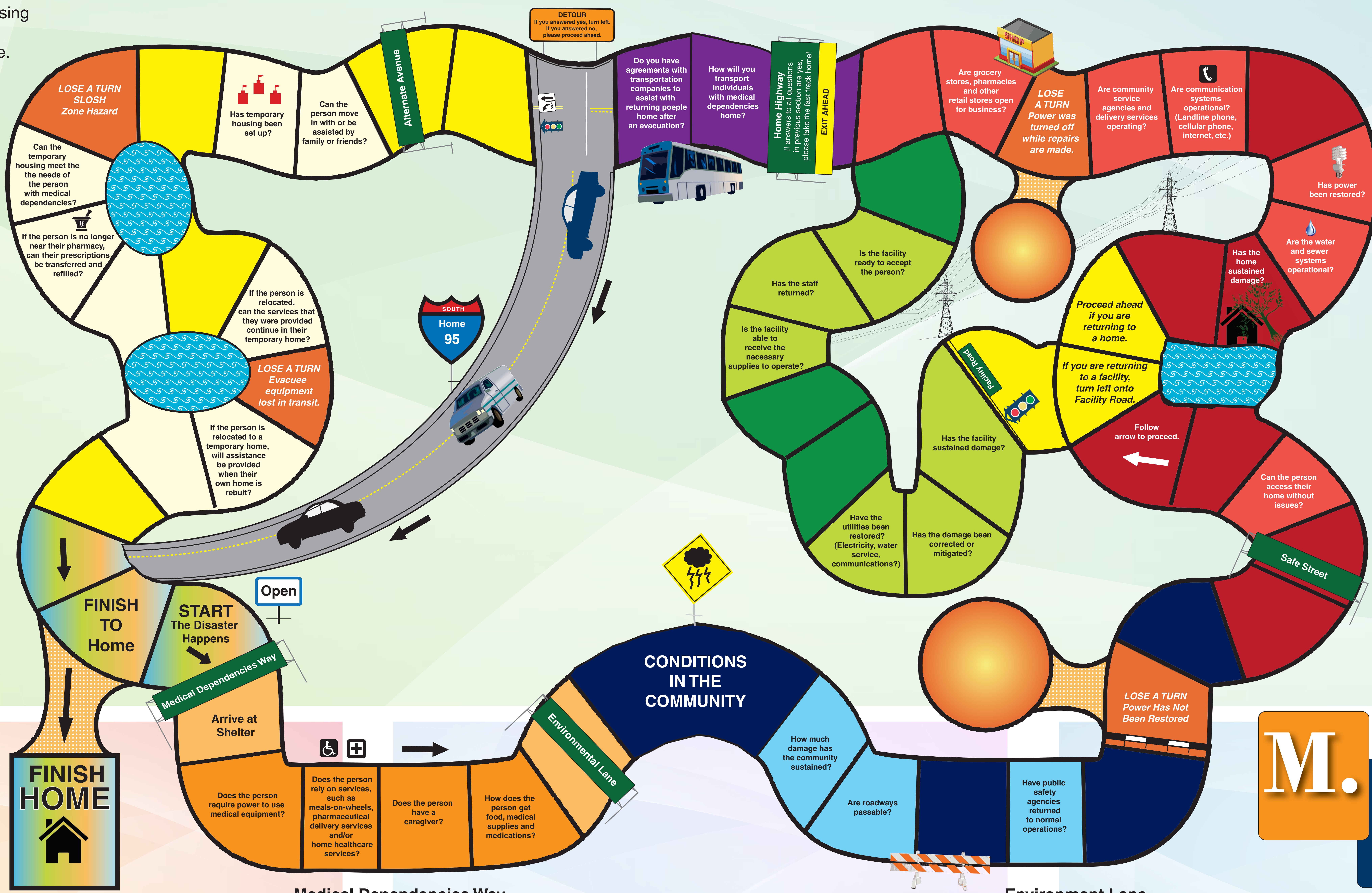
**Alternative Avenue**  
Identify alternative housing plans if individuals can not return home.

**A Person with Medical Dependencies:**  
A medically dependent person is someone who requires any of the following to sustain life:

- Medical or trained caregivers
- Equipment required for life sustainment
- Medications needed for life sustainment



**Safe Street**  
Determine if the condition at home is safe for return.



M.=Medical dependencies E.=Environment S.=Safety A.=Alternative

**Medical Dependencies Way**  
Determine the unique medical dependencies of the individual

**Environment Lane**  
Access the conditions of the community
